The Canaveral Port Authority is seeking proposals from qualified Construction Management/General Contracting firms to **provide Construction Management at Risk Services for Cruise Terminal 10 Lobby Expansion and Ticket Counter Upgrades for the Canaveral Port Authority, Cape Canaveral, Florida, PUR-RFP-12-6**. The Request for Proposal (RFP) is a two step process. Step 1 is a Qualifications and Short-Listing Proposal process, and Step 2 is a Price, Technical and Schedule Proposal process. Participation in Step 2 will be limited to Step 1 Proposers who were successfully short-listed.

Sealed Qualifications Proposals for Step 1 proposals will be received by the undersigned at the receiving area of Canaveral Port Authority, 445 Challenger Rd., Cape Canaveral, Florida 32920 for the First Response Fire Station & Operations Center on **February 28, 2012 until 2:00 PM-EDT (Eastern Standard Time)**. These services will be acquired in compliance with the Consultants Competitive Negotiations Act, Florida Statutes 287.055. Receiving area for sealed proposals is in rear of building and will be manned week days from 8 a.m. to 12 noon and from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. **(DO NOT LEAVE SEALED PROPOSALS WITH 1ST FLOOR SECURITY GUARD)**.

Step 2 of the Proposal process due date is tentatively set for March 29, 2012 until 2:00PM EST.
