QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:

1. **QUESTION CIF-01:** In reference to Submission Required Tab 04-Qualification Data - Similar Experience: It is stated "Projects must include or shown separately as additional examples of Civil/sitework...". Is it acceptable to shown these projects in addition to the five required showing similar experience, or are they to be counted as part of the five allowed.

RESPONSE: Each Proposer must demonstrate the experience of CM @ Risk on projects of similar size and scope on a minimum of five projects. Of 5 projects being presented, if

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they do not have the minimum requirements for civil/sitework, then additional projects must be included to demonstrate that the proposer has the minimum requirements for both the building and civil experience requested.

2. **QUESTION CIF-02:** Qualification Data - Similar Experience - Please define SPECIAL CATEGORY MATERIALS.

RESPONSE: Special Category Materials (SCM's) are also known as Owner Direct Purchases (ODP's) where a Contractor/Subcontractor includes material and equipment costs in their bid, (including all taxes and freight), that will be incorporated into the project. The Owner, being exempt from sales tax reserves the right to purchase materials and equipment included in the Contractor/Subcontractor's bid and or contract through an Owner's Purchase Order to save the sales tax on the purchase. All terms and conditions for the ordering, shop drawings/submittals, delivery, installation and warranty of the Owner Purchase materials and equipment are still the responsibility of the Contractor.
