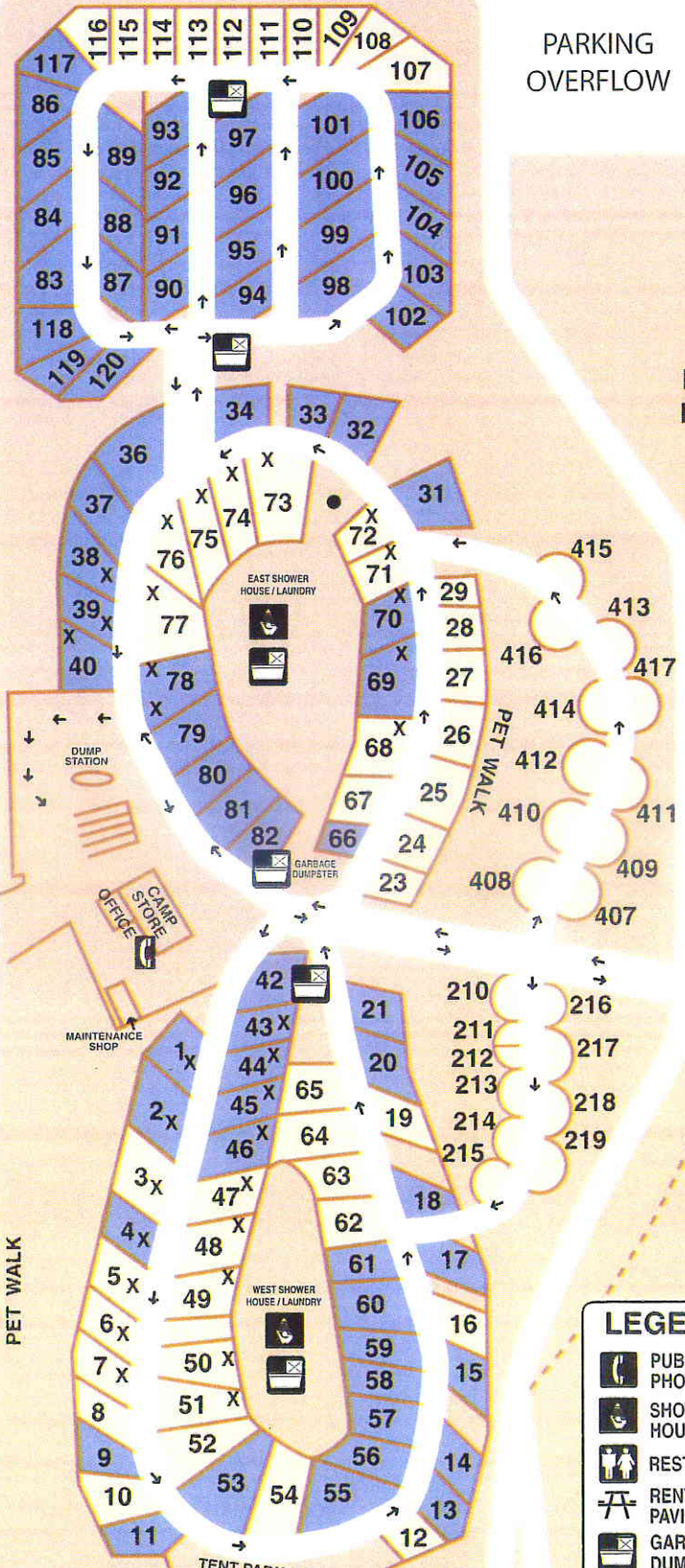
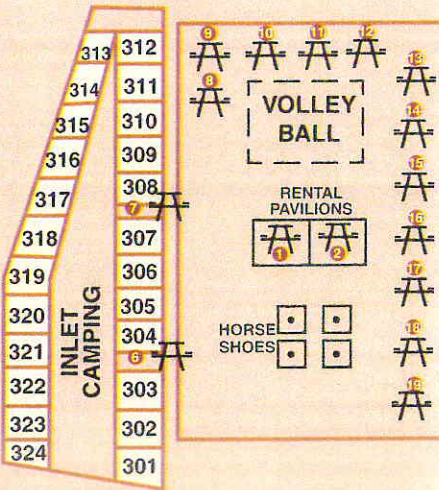

Jetty Park Good Neighbor Camping Rules

Thank you for choosing to visit Jetty Park. We are proud of our park and happy to have you as our guest. With your compliance with the following rules, we will do everything possible to ensure safe and enjoyable family camping experiences for you and your neighbors. Management reserves the right to evict a guest at its discretion. Violation of park rules may result in early departure without a refund.

RESERVATIONS: Reservations may be made up to 90 days in advance with a minimum two-night stay (maximum 21-day stay), unless arrangements are approved by Park management. Please note, there is no guarantee of site assignments. You must be at least 18 years of age to rent a campsite. Proof of age, permanent physical address, and a valid vehicle registration are required and subject to approval.

CAMPING: All campers, visitors, and guests must check in at the office upon arrival and prior to entering the campground. Tent camping is restricted to four consecutive days, unless approved by Park management. Limit: one camping unit, six people, and two cars per tent site. One additional tent is permitted on tent sites at a rate of \$10.00 per night. Winter rates apply to holidays and special events. West Tent and Inlet Tent areas are \$30.00 per tent per night. Camping fees include a 6% sales tax and a 5% tourist tax. Proper tents must be used. Tarps, covers, or lean-to's are not permitted. Campers are responsible for their site and may not leave camp site unattended for more than 24 hours. RV/Camping units must be approved units and contain the RVIA seal indicating they are built to code and provide proper safety and health standards. Campers are not permitted in day areas after 9 p.m. Check-out time is Noon.

GUESTS: Visitors are required to register at the office upon entering the park. All camp visitors are required to pay the parking fee, if applicable. There is no entrance charge for visitors entering on foot or bicycle. All visitors must leave the park by 10:00 p.m., unless registered as an overnight guest. Registered campers are responsible for ensuring their visitors are registered and that all campground rules are obeyed.

QUIET HOURS: 10:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m. Quality rest and relaxation is important to all campers, so please refrain from loud noises and disturbances during this period. All radios and TVs must be at minimum volume settings. Be aware that normal speaking voices carry. Please ensure your children remain at your site until 7:00 a.m.

PETS: Jetty Park is pet-friendly, but owners will be held responsible for their pets at all times. Pets cannot be left unattended at any time and must remain on a leash. You may not leave your pet inside your RV if you leave the campground. Two pet limit. Pets are allowed only in Class A, B, and C units and travel trailers. Pets are not allowed in the following: day areas, beach, pier, picnic pavilion(s), inlet areas 300's - 400's, and playground. Pets must be walked in designated pet walk areas ONLY. Campers are responsible for cleaning up after their pet(s). Those who are not in compliance will be asked to leave the park with no refund.

GRAY/BLACK WATER: The discharge of gray water into the environment has been found to be a significant risk to public health. Release of gray or black water is prohibited, except at designated dump stations.

OPEN FIRES/COOKING: Wood and/or artificial log fires are not permitted except in the approved fire pit near the pavilions. All fires must be fully extinguished after use. Charcoal and gas grills are allowed. No fires of any kind on beach.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: No motorized vehicles should be allowed on the beach or outside the campground.

BATHHOUSES: To avoid accidents and injuries, an adult should accompany children under the age of six years old to the bathhouse. We take pride in the cleanliness of our facilities and we would appreciate your help in maintaining them.

WILDLIFE: Please do not feed feral cats or any other wild animals in the Park. **Wildlife that has been fed loses their natural fear of humans and may create serious consequences for visitors by becoming a nuisance or aggressively seeking food.**

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY: A 24-hour cancellation notice is required. Failure to do so will result in a one-night camping charge to your credit card account. Jetty Park is not responsible for inclement weather or other unfortunate circumstances. Therefore, refunds are not permitted.



PROHIBITED – The following activities are strictly prohibited. Violators will be asked to leave the Park with no refunds:

- 1 Disorderly conduct
- 2 Use of portable generators (only factory installed systems are allowed)
- 3 Due to underground utilities, digging of any kind is not permitted
- 4 Disturbing turtle nesting sights
- 5 Walking on dunes
