

## EXPLANATION OF CONSENT AGENDA ITEM E.2.c. (3) November 16, 2016

### ITEM:

Consideration of approving two separate purchase orders to two CM at Risk Landside continuing contract services for port-wide Hurricane Matthew related repairs as follows:

- a. Ivey's Construction, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.
- b. W & J Construction in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

### EXPLANATION:

Existing landside CM at Risk contractors were mobilized in response to and immediately following the passing of Hurricane Mathew. These contractors have performed debris collection, emergency securing and safeing of infrastructure and repairs of various facilities.

Staff is requesting approval to award up to the contract value of \$2M for each of the continuing contracts to complete the required repairs from the hurricane damage. Following the initial 72 hour post-storm window, and in accordance with required FEMA practices, we have been collecting multiple quotes for all damaged items and have been authorizing the lowest qualified bidders to affect the repairs on a lump sum basis under the CM at Risk contracts.

**Funding Review by Finance (Pat Poston):** These contracts are for repairs which will be included in request for funding assistance through FEMA, and will be included in our initial insurance claim. They will be placed in a receivable account.
