EXPLANATION:

Per the 2016 Continuing Contract Renewal Matrix, the contract for Architectural, Planning, Design and Building Engineering Services Consultants will expire in April 2017. The current Consultants are: Atkins North America, Inc., BEA Architects, Inc., Bermello Ajamil & Partners, Inc., Construction Engineering Group, LLC, Architects RZK, Inc., and Reynolds, Smith & Hills, Inc.

Per the 2016 Continuing Contract Renewal Matrix, the contract for Threshold Inspection Services will expire in January 2017. The current Consultants are: Nodarse & Associates, Inc., a Terracon Company, TLC Engineering and Universal Engineering Sciences.

Per the 2016 Continuing Contract Renewal Matrix, the contract for Waterside General Engineering Services Consultants will expire in April 2017. Contract services will be performed under a standard Canaveral Port Authority continuing services contract reviewed and approved by the Port Attorney.
