CARGO



Port Canaveral is an economical and convenient ocean gateway into Florida. Located directly on the **main shipping lanes** along the East Coast of Florida, its deep draft main channel and unencumbered transit offer carriers highly efficient routing and reduced vessel costs. The Port has the berthing options, equipment, and facilities to handle a wide variety of vessels and cargoes, including bulk, break-bulk, containers, roll-on/roll-off, project, and heavy lift cargoes.

North Cargo Berths 3 and 4 now provide 1,747 linear feet of seawall and are dredged to -43 feet, expanding vessel capacity and operational flexibility. The Port operates three Liebherr LHM 600 **Mobile Harbor Cranes** delivering exceptional versatility and heavy-lift capability. Each crane offers a certified lifting capacity of 154 tons and an outreach spanning 18 containers across. Together, these cranes enhance the Port's ability to efficiently manage containerized, bulk, and project cargoes while supporting high-volume, multi-cargo operations.

As the grantee for **Foreign Trade Zone #136**, encompassing all of Brevard County, importers can benefit from many cost-saving advantages, such as efficient customs clearance, lower fees, inverted tariff relief, and the ability to quickly change or alter products.
