Sealed written Qualifications Proposals will be received by the undersigned at the Canaveral Port Authority, Maritime Purchasing Center, 399 Challenger Rd., Cape Canaveral, Florida until **May 6, 2025, at 2:00 PM-EDT (Eastern Daylight Time)**. The Maritime Purchasing Center is open weekdays from 8 AM to Noon and from 1 PM to 5 PM. Also, by the specified date and time, an electronic copy of the Qualifications Proposal must be uploaded through VendorLink.

A selection committee meeting will be held on May 13, 2025, at 2:00 PM for the purpose of reviewing proposals, ranking and possible shortlist selection. On May 20, 2025, the shortlisted firms will participate in oral interviews / presentations (if required), followed by another selection committee meeting at 2:00 PM to prepare the final ranking. The final ranking will be presented to the Canaveral Port Authority Board of Commissioners for approval at their June 4, 2025, meeting. The selection committee meetings will be held in the Maritime Purchasing Center, 399 Challenger Rd, Cape Canaveral, FL and will be open to the public.

It is anticipated that more than one firm may be selected. The Owner reserves the right to reject all proposals with or without cause, to waive technical errors and informalities, and to accept the proposal(s) that best serve(s) the Owner.
