Sealed Proposals will be received by the undersigned at Canaveral Port Authority, Maritime Purchasing Center, 399 Challenger Rd, Cape Canaveral, Florida 32920 for the Modular Mobile Passenger Boarding Bridge until **March 15, 2024, at 2:00 PM-EDT (Eastern Daylight- Saving Time)**. The Maritime Purchasing Center is open weekdays from 8 AM to Noon and from 1 PM to 5 PM.

Non-mandatory pre-proposal site visits are scheduled for 10:00 AM on February 20, 2024, and March 5, 2024, at 445 Challenger Rd, Cape Canaveral, FL 32920.

Presentations from all proposers will be heard on March 20, 2024, starting at 9 AM. A selection committee meeting will follow at 2:00 PM for the purpose of reviewing proposals, presentations and preparing a ranking. This ranking will be presented to the Canaveral Port Authority Board of Commissioners for approval at their regular March 2024 meeting. The selection committee meeting will be held at the Maritime Purchasing Center, 399 Challenger Rd, Cape Canaveral, FL and will be open to the public.
